

Nevada Dementia-Capable Community Care (NDC3)

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Goal of NDC3

Provide effective, sustainable, community-based services to people living with dementia, including people living alone with dementia and people living with I/DD and dementia, while delivering evidence-based dementia care consultation and training to both paid and unpaid primary caregivers.



Components of NDC3

- Timeline
 - Planning phase: September 2021 to December 2022
 - Implementation: January 2023 to December 2024
- Programs
 - Benjamin Rose Institute's Care Consultation (Neighbor Network of Northern Nevada)
 - To include free respite care & dementia-specific case management
 - NTG Dementia Capable Care of Adults with Intellectual Disabilities & Dementia training (Neighbor Network of Northern Nevada)
 - The Savvy Caregiver training in English & Spanish (Alzheimer's Association, Northern Nevada Region)



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- University of Nevada, Reno, Sanford Center for Aging for providing expert third-party evaluation support
- Northern Nevada Center for Independent Living for continuing to provide N4 with a home to do this work
